Update on Ordination of Bishop-elect Kulick



The upcoming Ordination and Installation Mass for Bishop-elect Larry J. Kulick, J.C.L., as the Sixth Bishop of the Diocese of Greensburg, will be celebrated Thursday, February 11, 2021 at 2:00 PM at the Blessed Sacrament Cathedral, Greensburg.

In an abundance of caution and in order to prioritize the health and safety of the faith community, attendance will be extremely limited and by invitation only. However, the entire diocesan community is invited to participate in the celebration, which will be available for viewing on our diocesan website, www.DioceseofGreensburg.org, on our diocesan Facebook page and YouTube Channel.

The Ordination Mass will also be broadcast on EWTN (Eternal Word Television Network) live at 2:00 PM, EST.
